SCE is an annual flagship event in China where companies get the opportunity to showcase their innovative digital solutions on a global platform and connect with Information and Communications Technology (ICT) companies from China and other parts of the world. There were 15 Singapore company booths under the Singapore Pavilion at the SCE.

There were open spaces and private meeting rooms available in the Singapore Pavilion for the companies to conduct their meetings and network with relevant parties. Business matchmaking sessions were incorporated into the programme itinerary to enhance support for the Singapore companies in sourcing and generating new business leads. Majority of the business matchings had taken place at the Singapore Pavilion at the SCE.

One of the key events of SCE is the Singapore (Chongqing) International Dedicated Connectivity (IDC) Forum, where 15 MOUs were signed between Singapore and China companies. At the IDC Forum, Mr Li Wei, Co-Opted Exco Member of SGTech Singapore Enterprise Chapter, announced the upcoming December 2023 launch of the China - Singapore Information and Communication Sector Market Access Guidebook. He shared that this guidebook would provide useful insights into the Chinese market, identifying market trends, gaps, opportunities, and more. This could help to further strengthen commercial ties between China and Singapore, fostering new growth in potential markets.

To enhance the Singapore delegates' business experience and to further understand the local markets in China, the programme had an extended visit to Chengdu.

Organised by Singcham in conjunction with IMDA, the Singapore delegates had attended a 1-day conference which aimed at creating business opportunities between tech companies from Singapore and Chengdu. Furthermore, the Singapore companies had visited the Jinjiang Software Park where they had shared about the Chinese government support for setting up a business in Chengdu and its future potential development plans.

The post-event survey indicates that most of the Singapore companies have gained better understanding of the Western China market, found potential business leads and partnerships, and expressed interest to take part in similar business missions in the future. Overall, there were positive feedback, and the business mission programme was a successful one.
